Dear Mr. Stamets:

El Paso Natural Gas Company recently received administrative approval NSL-2073 for a non-standard location for its Hancock #2A gas well. Due to a change of plans, El Paso intends to drill this location as the Hancock #6M well, a Blanco Mesa Verde/Basin Dakota dual well. This well will still be located 1025 feet from the South line and 530 feet from the East line of Section 29, T-28-N, R-9-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is requested to amend NSL-2073 to include the Basin Dakota pool at this location; and change the well name to show the dual completion.

El Paso Natural Gas Company is the offsetting operator of the surrounding area in both the Blanco Mesa Verde pool and the Basin Dakota pool.

Plats showing the proposed well location and the terrain in Section 29, along with an ownership plat, are attached.

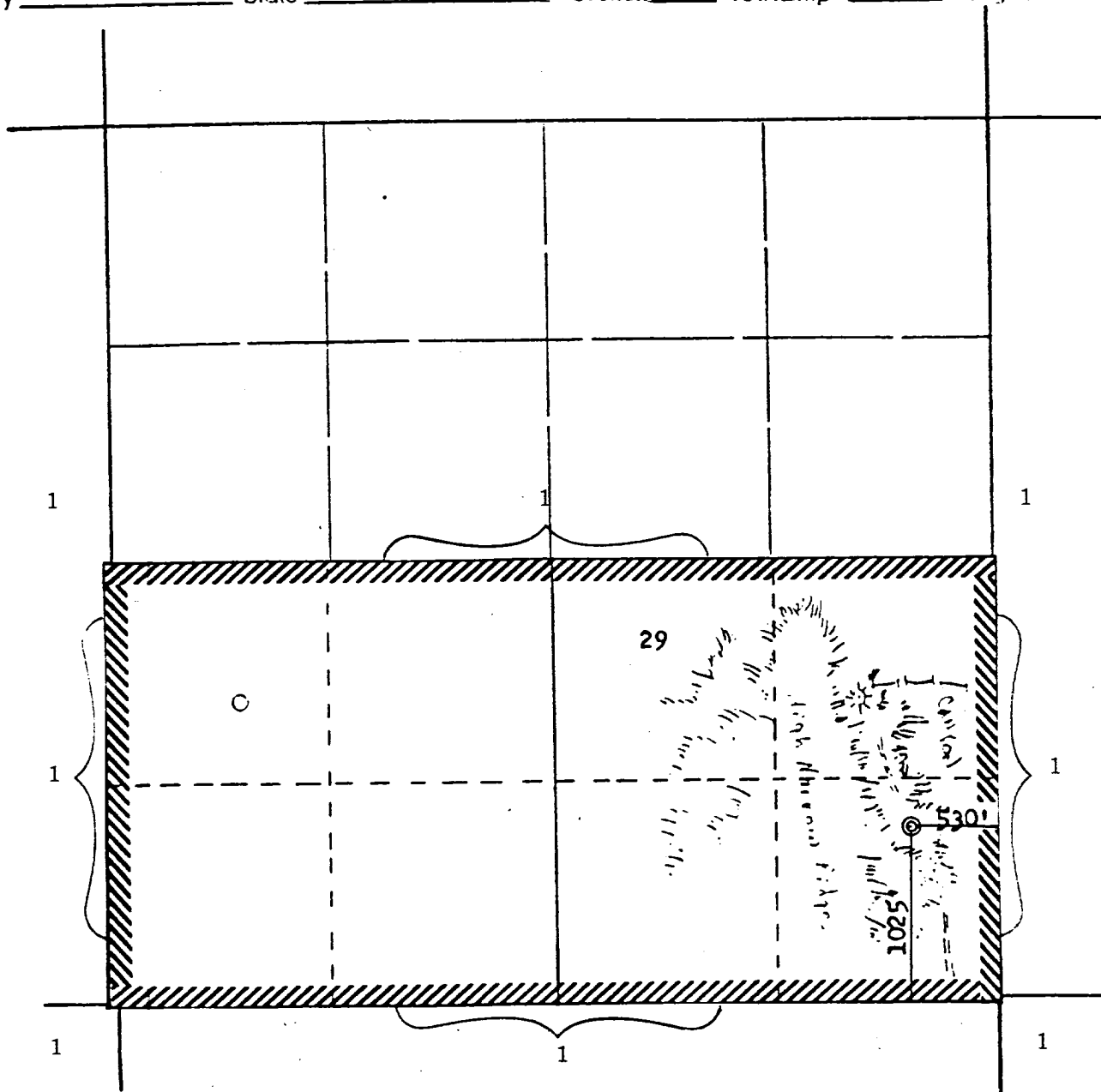
