Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your well No. 3 Indian A, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, sec. 29, T. 29 N., R. 3 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, Jicarilla Contract No. 81. The sundry notices received July 2, 1960, do not indicate your future plans for this well. If additional completion work is not anticipated to be conducted on this well within 60 days, it is necessary for you to furnish and perform the following items:

1. File a completion report (form 9-330) with this office.
2. File a request to temporarily abandon the well.

Please be advised a bridge plug will have to be placed above any open perforations and the surface shut-in to place the well in a satisfactory condition for temporary abandonment. Any temporary abandonment approved will be for a period of one year and at the end of that time you will be required to show cause as to why the well should not be permanently plugged and abandoned.

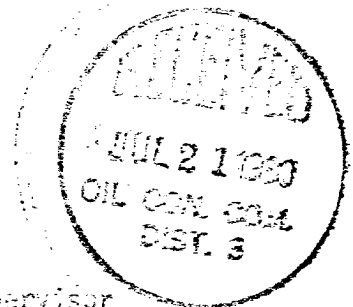
Authority for these actions is contained in 30 CFR 221 parts .34 Well Abandonment and . 59 Log and History of Well.
