This well was completed in December of 1961 for an IFF of 35 MOPD from perforis 1394' & 1398'-1400'. TD 1402', PHTD 1401' RM.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission by Order No. R-2763, dated 9-8-64 (an amendment to Order No. R-2564 authorizing institution of a pressure maintenance project in the subject pool by water injection) granted Continental permission to inject water into Table Mesa No. 23 & No. 22 in lieu of Table Mesa No. 25.

Produced water will be injected down the casing in the subject well. No remedial work is necessary to convert this well to water injection.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
