Federal reports filed on the above well indicate it was spudded March 26, 1960, drilled to a total depth of 5589 feet and that 5 1/2" casing was cemented at 5569 with 100 sacks. Reports filed also indicate that it was sand-oil fractures.

Copies of Federal well record form have never been received in this office showing whether the well was finally completed as a producing well or dry hole. We have learned from the U.S.G.S. that you tentatively planned to plug and abandon the well. Will you please file 5 copies of Federal well record form with the U.S.G.S. office in order that we may receive our copies. Will you also please indicate plans for permanently plugging and abandoning.
