We propose to return the subject well to water injection and plan to plug back from the Gallup "B" zone by setting a bridge plug at 5735' and dumping one sack of cement on the plug. A packer will be set at about 5580' and water will be injected down 2-3/8" tubing into the Gallup "A" zone at 5684-5706'.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, other than those shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
