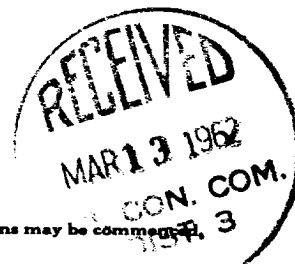
The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 5766 ft.

### DETAILS OF WORK

As a result of the above well ceasing to produce it was plugged and abandoned on March 7, 1962, as follows:

1. Rigged up unit and pulled tubing
2. Pumped 20 sacks Incon cement down 5-1/2" casing with top of plug at 1590'
3. Filled hole with fluid
4. Pumped 20 sacks Incon cement down 5-1/2"-10-3/4" annulus
5. Removed all surface equipment
6. Spotted 5 sacks Incon cement plug at surface
7. Erected abandonment marker and cleaned up location.
