The well is currently a plugged and abandoned Basin Dakota well. We plan to complete in the Gallup in the following manner:

1. Drill out surface plug and install heads.
2. Clean out to PEB.
3. Perforate Chm Chm Gallup interval 5676-84' with 4 spt.
4. Spot 250 gallons acid and free with 15,000 pounds 20-40 and 5000 pounds 10-20 sand in 20,000 gallons lease crude.
5. Shub in and test.
