

Reference is made to your application for approval of non-standard locations for your GCU-PC Well No. 267 located 1960 feet from the North line and 1700 feet from the East line of Section 23; your GCU-PC Well No. 268 located 430 feet from the South line and 430 feet from the East line of Section 32; your GCU-PC Well No. 271 located 1400 feet from the South line and 2500 feet from the East line of Section 27; and your GCU-PC Well No. 272 located 1100 feet from the North line and 2200 feet from the West line of Section 33, all in Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.
