Dear Mr. White:

Reference is made to your application of July 24, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your existing Angel Peak "B" Well No. 31 located 990 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 25, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 25 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
