

Gentlemen:

In your letter of August 17, 1990, you requested another one-year extension of the hardship classification granted in 1984 by the above order. The order approved a minimum flow rate of 88 MCF per day. In 1987 the minimum flow rate was reduced to 65 MCF per day. As requested, we are extending the hardship classification to May 31, 1991. Based on the declining producing rates, the minimum flow rate is hereby reduced to 50 MCF per day.
