Union Texas Petroleum wishes to advise that we have temporarily abandoned the Gallup. A drillable bridge plug was set at 5398', isolating Gallup perforations. The well was recompleted in the Chacra from 2879' to 2998' gross, acidized with 300 gals 7-1/2% HCl and 600 gals 15% HCl and 26 - 7/8" ball sealers, fraced with 68,000# 20/40 sand in 60,000 gals 70 Q N2 foam.
