Dear Mr. Bayless:

Reference is made to your application dated April 16, 1993 for a non-standard Pinon-Gallup oil well location for your existing **T. L. Rhodes "B" Well No. 1E** which was drilled in December 1984/January 1985 and completed in the Basin-Dakota Pool at a standard gas well location 790 feet from the South line and 1160 feet from the West line (~~Unit M~~) of **Section 20, Township 28 North, Range 11 West**, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Dakota zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted in the Undesignated Pinon-Gallup Oil Pool, which pursuant to RULE 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Pinon-Gallup Oil Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-3103, dated August 11, 1966, is considered to be unorthodox. Further, the S/2 SW/4 of said Section 20 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of RULE 5 of said Special Pool Rules, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
