Dear Mr. Cox:

Reference is made to your application dated May 10, 1999 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for Cross Timbers Oil Company's proposed E. H. Pipkin Well No. 31 (API No. 30-045-29774) to be drilled 2510 feet from the North line and 555 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 35, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. The E/2 of Section 35 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 320-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 104.F of the Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and Rule 8 of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of these special pool rules and Division Rule 104.F (2), the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
