Started flowing drlg. mud & salt water for remainder of test, Closed tool for 90 Min. build up press.. Recovered 7145' of salt water. No Shows. IHP 3704#, FHP 3661#, ITP 439#, FTP 3226#, 30 Min. build up press., 60 Min. & 90 Min. 3487#.
