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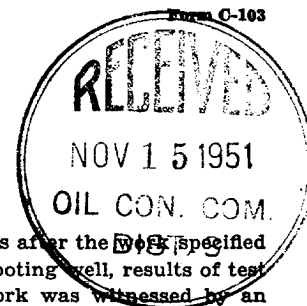

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was spudded at 10:00 P.M., October 25, 1951. On October 30, 1951, 10-3/4" casing was landed at 699 feet and cemented with 400 sacks of cement. Cement circulated to surface. Cement plug down at 12:15 P.M., October 30, 1951. At 3:30 A.M., November 1, 1951, casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes, with no drop in pressure. Forty-five feet of solid cement was drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.

### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On November 18, 1951, 7" casing was landed at 3870 feet and cemented with 350 sacks of cement and 75 sacks of Signalight. Plug down at 11:30 A.M., November 18, 1951. At 4:00 P.M., November 21, 1951, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1200 lbs. pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Sixty-seven feet of solid cement was drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1200 lbs. for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.
