
Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 303.A. of the Distinct Rules and Regulations to permit the above described well to commingle production from the in the wellbore.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to to provisions of Rule 303.C., and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such downhole to and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to continue the production as described above and any Division Order which authorized the dual contrequired separation of the zones is hereby placed in abeyance.

The maximum amount of gas which may be produced daily from the well shall be domined by Division Rules and Regulations or by the gas allowable for each respective prorated point the Division's San Juan Basin Gas Proration Schedule.
