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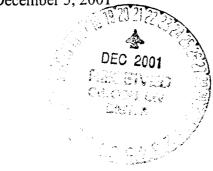

Dear Ms. Corley:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application dated November 8, 200 **e**pplication reference No. pKRV0-131857452); and (ii) the records of the New Mexico Oil Division ("Division") in Santa Fe: all concerning Amoco Production Company's ("Ar for an exception to the well location requirements provided within the "Special Rules I Mesaverde Pool," as promulgated by New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Div No. R-10987-A, issued in Case No. 12069 and dated February 1, 1999, of an unorthe well for the existing Trigg Federal Gas Com. "B" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-26364) feet from the South line and 875 feet from the East line (Lot 9/Unit I) of Section 15 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Blanco-Mesaverde Pool (72319), San Juan County,

According to the Division's well records, the Trigg Federal Gas Com. "B" W No. 1 was drilled to a total depth of 7,584 feet in 1985 by Amoco and completed in the Basin-D a Pool. By Division Administrative Order NSL-2016, dated April 1, 1985, this unorthodox gas l location was approved as an initial well in the Basin-Dakota Pool within a standard 303.67-acre down gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") comprising Lots 9 through 16 (S/2 equivalent) of etion 15. It is our understanding that Amoco intends to perforate the Blanco-Mesaverde gas recomplete this well such that production from both intervals will be commingled described upon issuance of this order.

This Blanco-Mesaverde gas production is to be included within an existing sta acre lay-down GPU that also comprises Lots 9 through 16 (S/2 equivalent) of Section the subject of Division Administrative Order NWU-132, dated May 27, 1955) ar dedicated to Amoco's: (i) Cole Gas Com. "A" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-08240 standard gas well location 1470 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the 11/Unit K) of Section 15; and (ii) Cole Gas Com. "A" Well No. 1-A (API No. 3 located at a standard infill gas well location 800 feet from the South line and 1460 fee line (Lot 15/Unit O) of Section 15.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 10 and 605.B.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F the abovedescribed unorthodox Blanco-Mesaverde infill gas well location for the Trigg Federal Well No. 1 is hereby approved. Further, all three of the aforementioned Cole Gas Co A" Wells No. 1 and 1-A and Trigg Federal Gas Com. "B" Well No. 1, and existing 303.67-acm **P**U will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to prorate s pools in Northwest, New Mexico and to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Further, the provisions of Division Administrative Order NSL-2016 shall remain full force and effect until further notice.
