June 21, 1953 - Ran 170 joints - 7" O.D. - 23# J&L, J-55 seamless casing. Set at 5,575 feet. Cemented with 225 sacks - 175 of Gel cement, and 50 of Regular Ideal. Plug down at 9:35 A.M.

June 24, 1953 - Drilled the plug. Both before and after drilling the plug, tested with 500# pressure for 30 minutes and found all right - there being no indicated drop.
