We hereby request permission to drill an unorthodox location to test the Mesa Verde formation. This well is to be located 2160' from the South line and 480' from the West line of Section 27, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, N. M. P. M. Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This request is made for the following reasons:

1. This well being a wildcat, future locations are in doubt.
2. Operator has lease on the entire South half (S/2) of Section 27.
3. Orthodox location would be in rock hill site (D. Flat) and would cause excessive expense to operator on first well.
4. Off-set operator, Phillips Petroleum Company has no objection to this location.

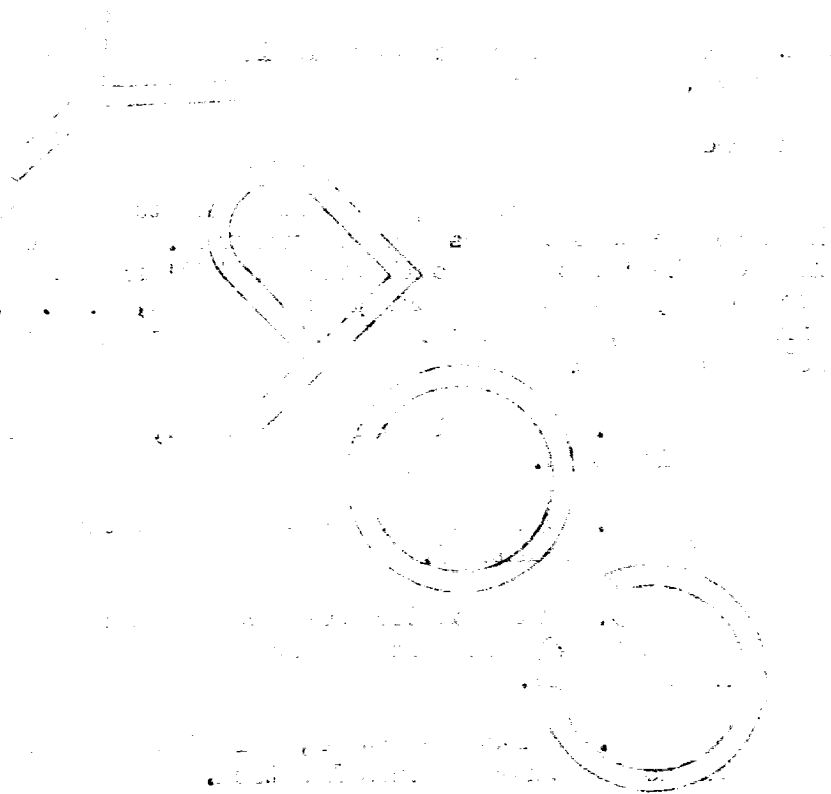
