Administrative application of Phillips Petroleum Company dated January 19, 2000 for an exception to the well location requirements provided within the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, dated October 17, 1988, as amended by Division Orders No. R-8768-A, dated July 16, 1991, and R-8768-B, issued in Case No. 12296 and dated February 10, 2000 (see copy attached), to drill the San Juan "30-5" Unit Well No. 220-R (API No. 30-039-26200) at an unorthodox coal gas well location 1147 feet from the South line and 2570 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 8, Township 30 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as a replacement well within an existing standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool comprising the W/2 of Section 8.

The proposed well site for the San Juan "30-5" Unit Well No. 220-R and surrounding area have been inspected by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's Aztec district office.
