DETAILS OF WORK

This hole is being drilled for geological information. The objective is the Fluvial (Gulf) at approximately 3300'. Prepared to drill to 3500' - 22" surface hole to 22" - 8-1/2" surface casing and cement with 50 rods - to drill 7-1/2" hole below surface casing approximately 3300'. Will run electric log and plug according to plan set out by U.S.G.S. Oil & Gas Division.
