DETAILS OF WORK

1. Rigged up rotary tools, spudded 12 1/4" hole at 1:00 a.m. 10/2/62.
2. Drilled to TD of 275'. Ran 8 joints 8-5/8", 24.00#, H-40 casing, set at 275'. R.K.B. Cemented with 200 sacks regular, 2% Calcium Chloride. Plug down at 11:30 a.m. 10/3/62. Circulated cement.
3. Pressured up to 1000# for 30 minutes. Pressure held ok.
4. Drilling ahead with 7-7/8" hole.
