

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Rig up rotary tools. Spud 12 1/2" surface hole 12:30 a.m. 9/5/62.
2. Drilled to T.D. of 285'. Ann 8 joints 8-5/8" ID., 24.00#, 8-40 surface casing. Landed at 285' R.L.L. Cemented w/200 sacks regular cement w/2 1/2 Calcium Chloride.
3. Cement circulated. Plug down 1:30 p.m. 9/5/62.
4. Pressured up on surface casing to 1000 psi for 30 minutes. Pressure held 2:00 p.m. 9/6/62.
5. Drilling ahead with 7-7/8" hole.
