Permission is requested to dually complete this well in the Pictured Cliffs and Mesaverde formations. We propose to set casing, perforate and sand-water frac these two zones, install dual parallel tubing strings with an acceptable tubing anchor and separation packer at approximately 2300'.

The acreage dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs is the NE 1/4, consisting of 160 acres. The E 1/2, consisting of 320 acres, is dedicated to the Mesa-verde.
