A copy of this letter is being sent to the Antec office of this Commission, in whose district the location will be produced.

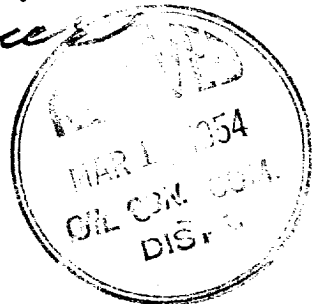
