Dear Sir:

During the 1957 Annual Deliverability Testing season, considerable difficulty was experienced in obtaining a satisfactory test on the L. V. Hamner "B" No. 1 in the Blanco Mesaverde Field. This was due to the well's inability to flow continuously through either the tubing or casing alone without logging off, making it necessary to reschedule the well for deliverability test three different times.

This well is normally produced through both the tubing and casing, and it is requested that we be allowed to conduct the 1958 Annual Deliverability Test in this manner in exception to the requirements of Order No. R-333-C and D. This will permit obtaining a fairly representative test without the extensive testing previously undertaken.

The L. V. Hamner "B" No. 1 was finally tested during the 1957 Annual Deliverability period at a flow rate of 26 MCF of gas per day with a calculated deliverability of 51 MCF of gas per day. The well produced an average of 23 and 68 MCF of gas per day during January and February, 1958, respectively.
