Dear Mr. Mishler:

Division Order No. R-6313 authorized Tenneco Oil Company to commingle Chacra and Mesaverde production within the wellbore of ten proposed wells.

It is my understanding that two of these wells must be moved as noted below because of their original proximity to an irrigated field and a flood control underground drainage system.

Tenneco is hereby authorized to drill and complete these two wells as described below:

The Marquic & Eaton "A" Well No. 1E being moved from Unit A to Unit B of Section 25, Township 29 North, Range 11 West; and

the Bruce Sullivan Com "B" Well No. 1 being moved from Unit D to an unorthodox location, hereby approved, 1990 feet from the West line and 530 feet from the North line of Section 25, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, both in San Juan County, New Mexico.
