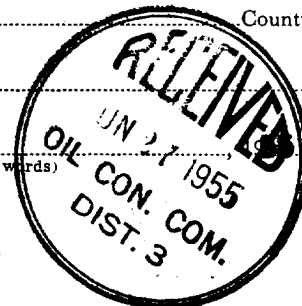

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED



Sand-Oil Frac by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company at 1533 feet with 5,000 gal. of oil, 38 sacks of sand, 15 gal of Morflo. Break down pressure- Maximum 1800 lbs., minimum 700 lbs., 18 BPM, Total pump time- 7 minutes. Sand-Oil Frac unsuccessful, no gas in commercial quantities. Well seems to be emulsified. Will continue bailing and cleaning for approximately one week.

May 13, 1955, drilled 15 more feet to a T.D. of 1548 feet then shot with 30 quarts of S.N.G. by Rock Glycerin Company. Increase in gas.

Present Status of well: Continuing to blow and bail down under the supervision and advise of the Halliburton Oil well Cementing Co., plan to re-frac in the very near future. Basin Natural Gas Field-Supt.
