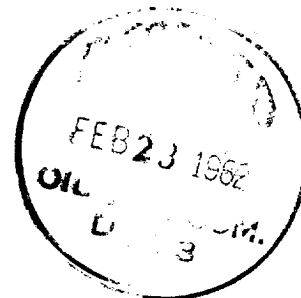
We also respectfully request that we be granted the 15-day extension to the 45-day test period on the following wells due to interrupted tests and late test scheduling:
