Dear Sir:

In the captioned Order it is stated that any well drilling to or completed in the Gallup formation that does not comply with the well location requirements of Rule 3, the operator must notify your office in writing of the name and location of the well on or before January 1, 1964.

We wish to advise that Navajo Tract 2 Well No. 1 located 990' fsl & 983' fwl Section 18-T29N-R15W, San Juan County, New Mexico, does not meet the 150 foot limitation as stated in Rule 3.


The Order also states that any operator desiring to dedicate more than 40 acres to a well must file a new form C-128 on or before January 1, 1964. Please find attached completed C-128 forms for five wells as listed below:
