DETAILS OF WORK

Rotary drilling equipment will be used to drill to approximately 4250', a Senessee log. Casing Program 200' of 8-5/8" cemented to surface. Required amount of 1/2" production casing will be run and cemented with sufficient volume of cement to cover the highest potentially productive zone. That program will consist of native sand from surface to 3000', and a low solids gel with 5 to 7 cc loss to total depth. Electric logs, etc. will be run prior to setting productive casing or abandonment of well. One cow is anticipated through pay. Stimulation treatments such as acidizing or fracturing may be employed in completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.


