We plan to abandon this well on or about September 30, 1987 with the following procedure:

1. Circulate the well with 9 ppg mud.
2. Install BOP.
3. Spot a 10 sx plug below the retainer @ 3660'.
4. Spot a 20 sx plug on top of the retainer.
5. Tag plug after WOC (3450').
6. Spot a plug from 1972' to 2193' to cover the PC & Fruitland Formation.
7. Perforate @ 850', squeeze 40 sx behind csg, spot 30 sx inside csg to cover the Kirtland & Ojo Alamo formations.
8. Perforate @ 379' & circulate cement to surface.
9. Cut off wellhead & install Dry Hole Marker.
