

The above captioned well was bridged in the Menafée section of the Mesa Verde formation in 1957. The tubing in this well was perforated on November 14, 1957, above the bridge thus allowing gas production from the Cliff House zone to be produced through the tubing string.

Previously this year we submitted an annual deliverability test on this well, the attached test is a corrected copy using the correct tubing length in the friction calculations. Also a form C-104 is being filed on this well at this time asking for a new allowable by reason of the remedial work of perforating the tubing.
