Administrative Order NSL-290

Dear Mr. Dugan:

It has been called to our attention that a typographical error was committed by this office in issuing Administrative Order NSL-290, dated March 5, 1962.

Administrative Order NSL-290 authorized Redfern & Herd, Inc., to drill a test well at an unorthodox well location 2200 feet from the South line and 1450 feet from the West line of Section 2, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, Basin-Dakota Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. Administrative Order NSL-290 should have authorized Redfern & Herd, Inc., to drill 2220 feet from the South line instead of 2200 feet from the South line of said section. Accordingly, Administrative Order NSL-290 is hereby amended nunc pro tunc to authorize Redfern & Herd, Inc., to drill a test well located 2220 feet from the South line and 1450 feet from the West line of Section 2, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, Basin-Dakota Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.
