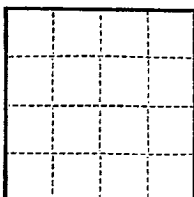

DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 1-10-61. Drilled 6-3/4" hole to 52'. Set 7-5/8" casing at 52' with 50 sacks of cement. Drilled 4-3/4" hole to 1124'. Run Schlumberger Electric Log from 56' to 1123'.

Propose to set 20 sack cement plug at 1090' and 12 sack cement plug at 90' and 5 sack cement plug at surface. This will be final abandonment.
