Well Spudded July 6, 1956.

Drilled to TD 183' reamed to 155' Set (4 jts) 130' at 10 3/4" 32.75#

Elect-Weld Casing, landed at 144', cemented w/ 150 sacks. Casing was pressured to 500# for 1 hr. with no drop in pressure. After cement set, plug was drilled and runs on B.O.P. were allowed and pressured to 500# for 30 minutes with no appreciable drop in pressure. Drilling ahead was resumed.


