Dear Mr. Porter:

Walter Duncan proposes to drill a test to be located 1310' from the north line and 330' from the west line of Section 7, Township 29 North, Range 16 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. Enclosed for your information is a photocopy of the well location plat prepared by Mr. Frederick H. Reed, Registered Land Surveyor.

We realize this is an irregular location; however, we request administrative approval to drill the location as staked because of topographic reasons: The location is 18' from a steep cliff going down to the San Juan River, and in order to effectively test as an offset to our producing Walter Duncan, North Hogback 12, Well No. 1, this is the best geographic location we could arrive at. Walter Duncan is also the owner of the leases adjoining to the north and to the west. For your information we have also prepared and enclose herewith a plat showing the proposed location, the river and the cliff.
