Gentlemen:

Our records indicate that there are several wells on the reservation which are owned by the Navajo Tribe.

This well was originally drilled by Amerada Hess Corporation and then turned over to the Navajo Tribe by a letter from Amerada to the BIA. It was supposed to supply gas for the NTUA but the well has been neglected for many years.



These four wells were last operated by Vista Resources, Inc. and were abandoned to neglect when the company became defunct. Two of these wells are being used for stock watering.

We are currently automating our well records and it is important to put these wells under the correct documented ownership. If you are actually responsible for these wells could you send us a memorandum or letter to that effect to make it official in our records or otherwise inform us that these wells do not belong to the tribe.
