This letter will confirm my telephone conversations with Mr. David Catanach of your Santa Fe office and Mr. Frank Chavez of your Aztec office. Amoco plans to surface commingle production from the two wells referenced above. Both of these wells produce from the Basin Dakota Pool in the same E/2 Section 10 spacing unit with identical ownership (WI, RI, ORRI).

Amoco will allocate production to each well on the basis of annual tests of the two wells. Based on our review of the NMOCD Rules and Regulations and telephone conversations with Mr. Catanach and Mr. Chavez, no further approvals are necessary for this commingling.
