By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.

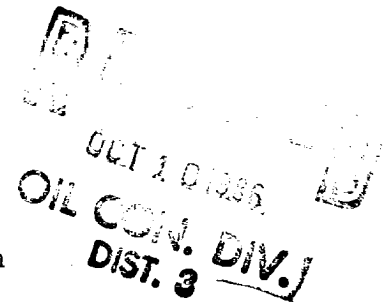

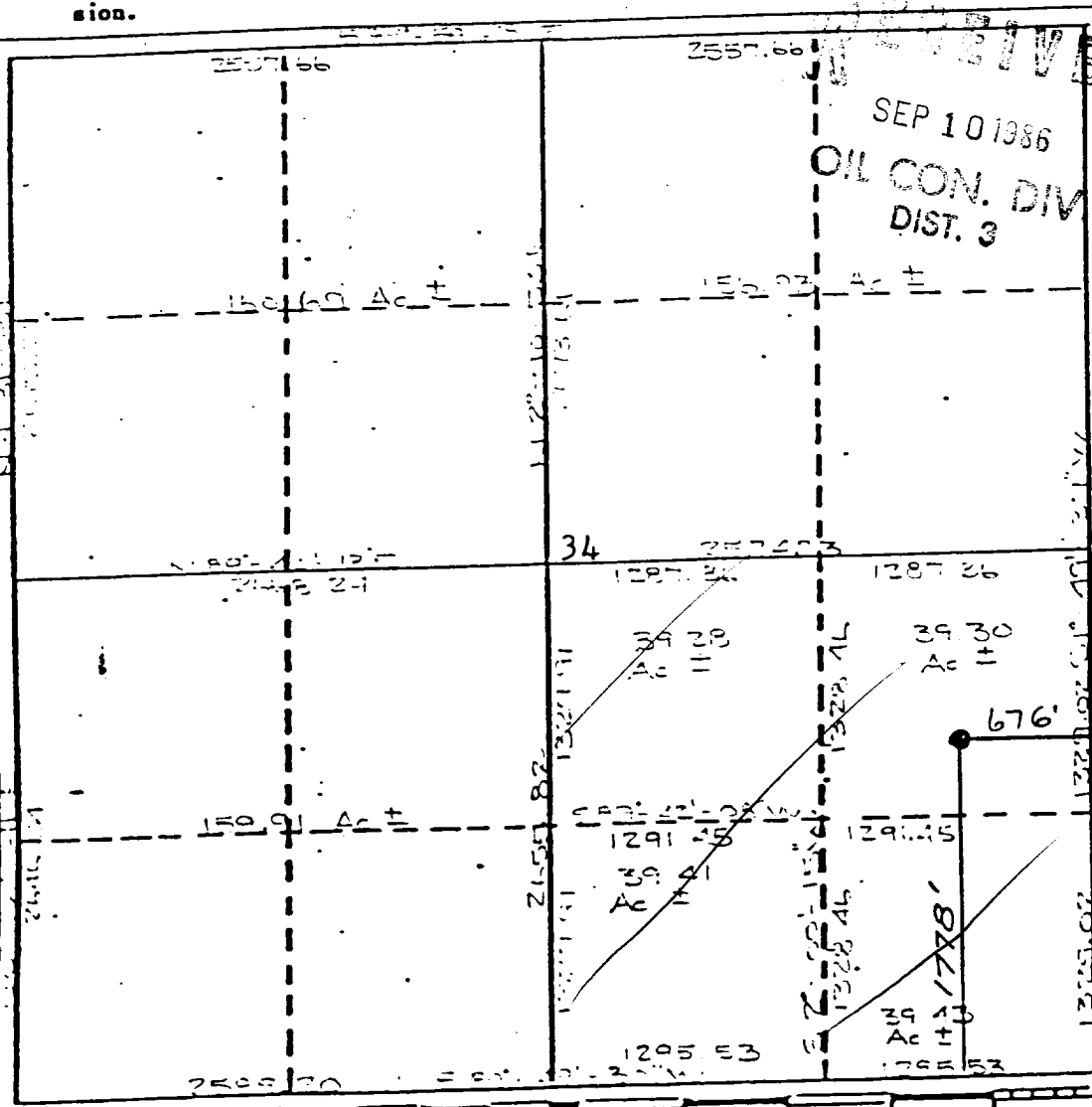

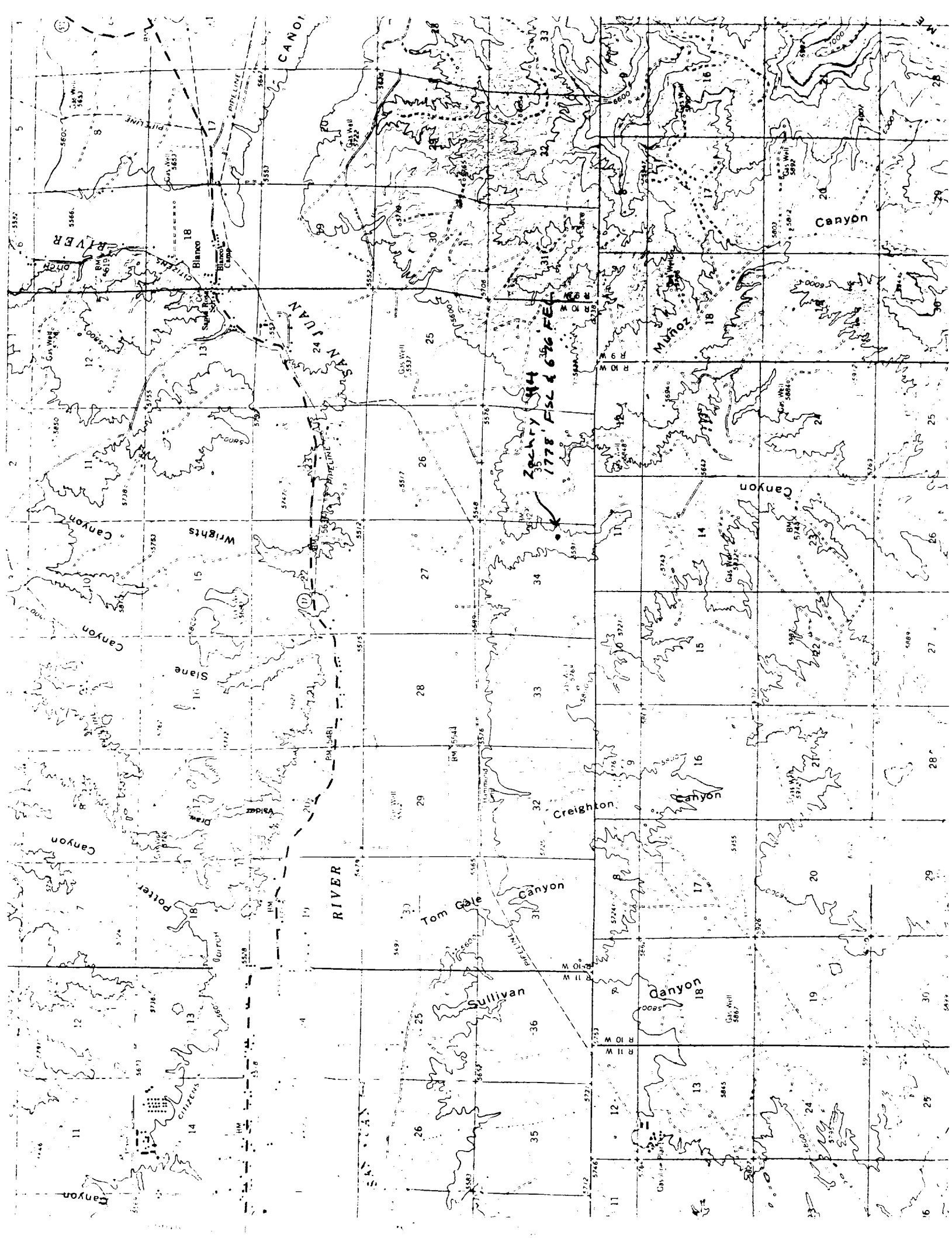
