It is proposed by Texaco, Inc. to install 2-2" nominal schedule 40, 0.154" wall, plain end API line pipes; one for gas gathering and one for water disposal purposes. Each line will be 1063.11' in length and will begin at a point near the compressor site (refer to "take off" on attached survey) and will terminate at the wellhead of the HJ LOE Fed. B #4 (See survey). The gathering lines will be installed in the same ditch, 18" wide by 36-48" deep. Total ROW width will be 40', 20' each side of centerline. Maximum operating pressure anticipated is 500 psig and the lines will be tested to 1-1/2 times the operating pressure prior to backfilling.

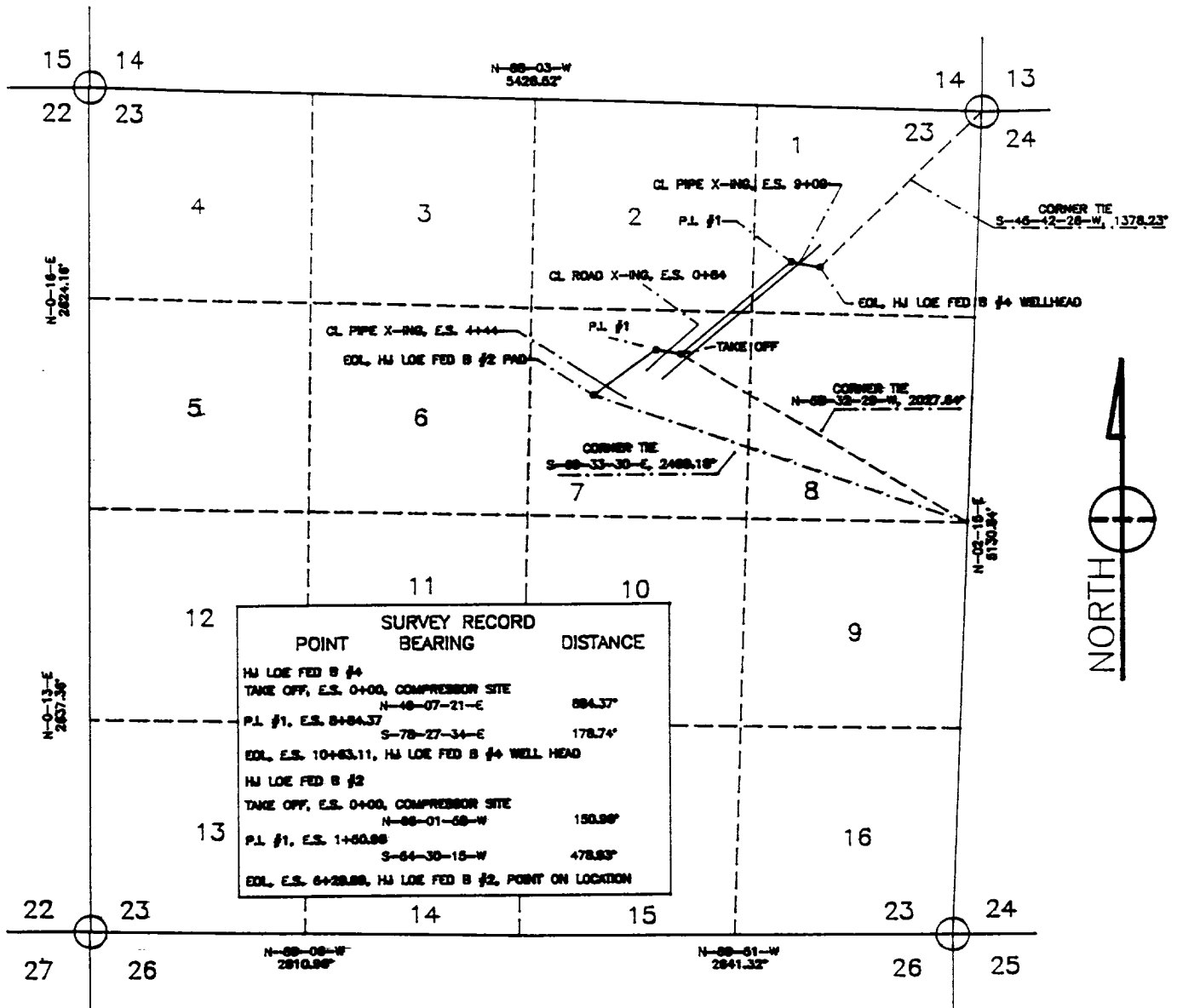
In addition, 1 - 2" nominal schedule 40, 0.154" wall, plain end API line pipe will be installed for water disposal purposes from the compressor site (refer to "takeoff" on the attached survey) to a point on the HJ LOE Fed. B #2 location (See attached survey). The line will be installed in an 18" wide by 36-48" deep ditch. Total ROW width will be 40', 20' each side of centerline. Maximum anticipated operating pressure is 500 psig and the line will be tested to 1-1/2 times this value prior to backfilling. This line length will be 629.89'.

Total BLM land, 1693' long x 40' wide

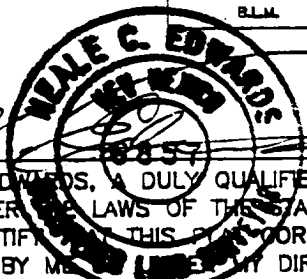
