
A review of our files shows your well No. 6 Rosa Unit located in the SW¹/₄SW¹/₄, sec. 27, T. 31 N., R. 5 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico on Federal lease No. SF-078770 was temporarily abandoned on August 3, 1953.

In accordance with 30 CFR 221.34 you are required to promptly plug and abandon any well on the leased land that is not used or useful for purposes of the lease but no productive well shall be abandoned until its lack of capacity for further profitable production of oil and gas has been demonstrated to the satisfaction of the supervisor.

Please inform this office within 30 days from the date of this letter of your plans to either return well No. 6 Rosa Unit to a productive status or arrange to furnish evidence to prove that the well is not capable of producing oil or gas in paying quantities.

If you have no plans to place well No. 6 Rosa Unit on production, please submit your Sundry Notice of Intention to Plug and Abandon within 30 days from the date of this letter.
