Your well record when filed will undoubtedly reflect all the operations which have been carried on and any final completion data.*

I would suggest that you contact Mr. Darrell Canfield in El Paso's Farmington office on this matter. Mr. Canfield is manager of Lands and Explorations and should be well informed on unit agreement commitments.*
