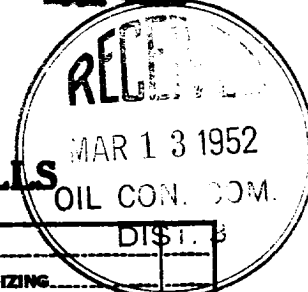

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was drilled to a depth of 1300 feet with cable tool rig, February 27, 1952, on this date operations were discontinued due to impassable roads caused by additional snow and continuous freezing and thawing weather which made it impossible for trucks to deliver fuel and water to the location. It is hereby requested that operator be allowed to suspend operations until weather is sufficiently improved to open roads and resume operations. Contractor's rig will be left on location in order to resume operations at earliest possible date.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
