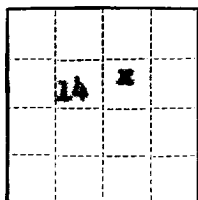

DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill to 200' and set 10-3/4" casing, cement to surface. Set 7-5/8" casing @ 3635', cement to 1000' above shoe using 8% gel w/50 sz neat on bottom. Set 5-1/2" liner @ 5870', cement w/150 sz reg. Test top of liner and Bradenhead sqs w/50 sz reg if necessary.

Purf and frac Mesa Verde using approx 150,000 gals water. Clean out to total depth, run tubing and complete well.

The E/2 of Section 14, containing 320 acres, is dedicated to this well.

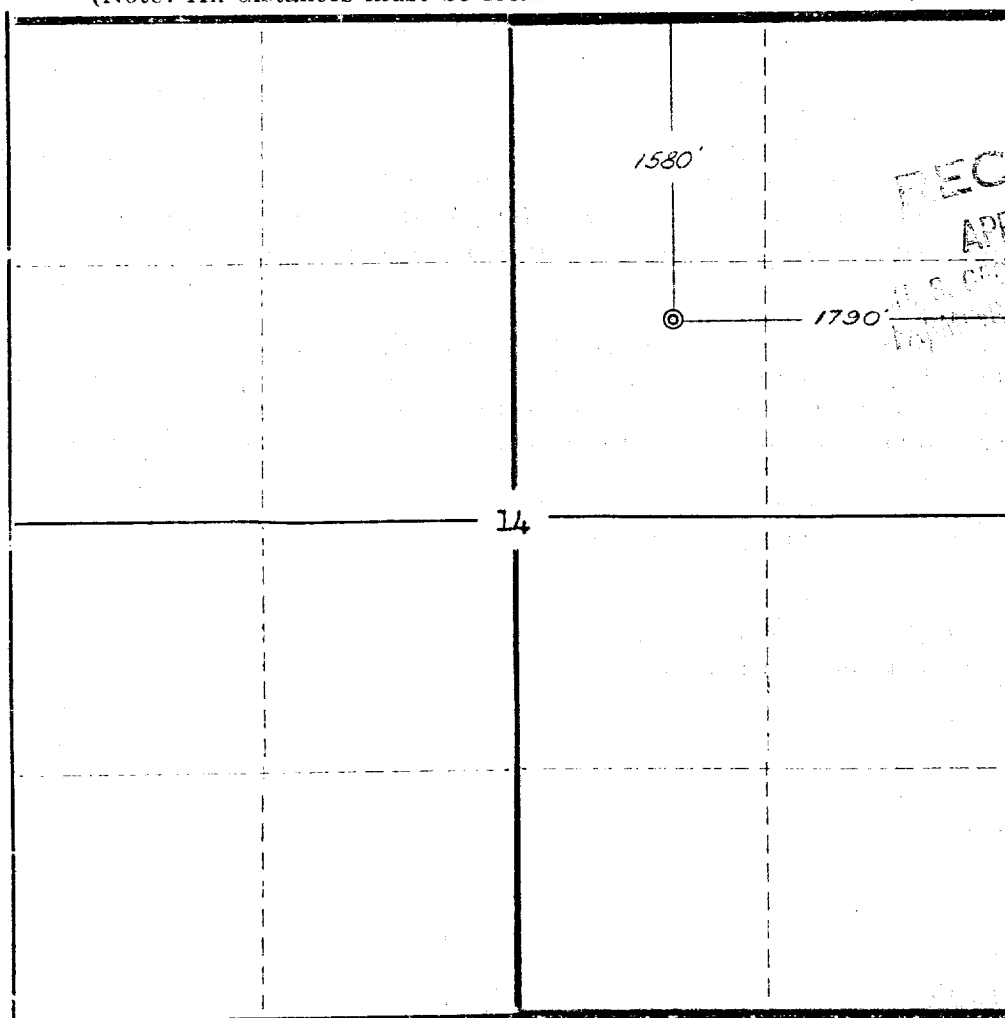
