

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a monstandard location for your Rosa Unit Well No. 11-15, to be located 1160 feet from the North line and 635 feet from the Fast line of Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 6 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the request for such exception is based upon extreme topographic relief and the advent of flooding the standard location by the proposed Navajo Dam in the NE/4 of said Section 15.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1, Section (c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-110, you are hereby granted an exception to the normal spacing requirements for the above well to be drilled in Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 6 West.
