Gentlemen:

On February 18, 1975, approval was granted for the drilling of your No. 36 Rosa Unit well to be located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 4, T. 31 N., R. 5 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on Federal oil and gas lease Santa Fe 078763.

By sundry report dated June 18, 1975, you indicated that this well would not be drilled. Such intent was orally confirmed by your Mr. L. O. Speer on July 10, 1975. It is our understanding that the well pad and pits that were prepared for the subject location have been restored to the satisfaction of the U.S. Forest Service.

Your approval to drill the subject well is hereby rescinded and your cancelled "Notice of Intention to Drill" is returned herewith.

If, at some later date, you should decide to drill a well at this site, it will be necessary for you to re-file a new application.
