As operator of the Northeast Blanco Unit, we are requesting administrative approval for an unorthodox well location to be completed in the Mesaverde Zone.

We intend to drill the Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 22A, an infill well, located 910' from the South line and 1970' from the East line of Section 36, T-31-N, R-7-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Due to topographical conditions and its relation to La Jara Wash, we can not locate the well any nearer the East line of Section 36.
