MEC efforts to begin workover operations on this well have been delayed by the Carson National Forest Service in an attempt to determine significant cultural resources existing along the Bancos Canyon Road which are under the stewardship of the National Forest Service. Dr. Richard P. Watson, Director of the San Juan College Cultural Resources Management Program, is currently appraising the sites along the road and will recommend action to protect the resources to the Carson National Forest Archaeologist and the State Historic Preservation Officer, who will in turn prescribe to MEC the conditions under which this well can be re-completed. MEC does not anticipate permission to work in the area until after the August 24, 1984 termination date of the status of TA (as per attached Sundry Notice). MEC does intend to complete the work as per previous Sundry Notice as soon as given authority to proceed.
