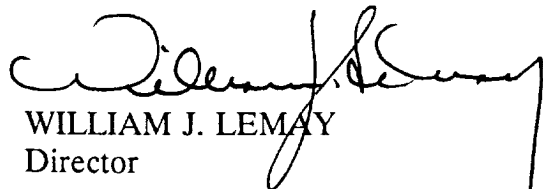
Dear Mr. Hulse:

Reference is made to your application dated August 3, 1992 for a non-standard gas well location for your San Juan Unit 31-6 Well No. 33-E to be located 1264 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 34, Township 31 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Basin Dakota Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Said well is to be an infill well, pursuant to Rule 2(b)2 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin Dakota Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, to your San Juan 31-6 Unit Well 33, located in Unit G and is currently dedicated to the N/2 of said Section 34 being a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of said Special Pool Rule, the above-described unorthodox infill gas well location is hereby approved.
